The new facility will have an exciting new branch design, which was just introduced in VyStar’s 39th and most recent branch, located in Ormond Beach in northeast Volusia County. The new branch design incorporates a fresh new look and enhanced technology designed to increase efficiency and improve member experience in the branch.

Terry West said, “VyStar opened its first branch in Fernandina Beach over 13 years ago, and we appreciate the support the community has shown us over the years. We look forward to opening our brand-new facility next year and enjoying many more years of service to the Fernandina Beach community.”

During construction of the *new* facility, VyStar will continue to provide uninterrupted service to their members at a temporary location, just one mile north, in the 8 Flags Shopping Center (1014 South 14th Street, Fernandina Beach, FL 32034). The move to the temporary location will take place on Saturday, September 24th after normal close of business at 3:00 p.m.
